Akaka shared the work being done on the Teacher Development Reimbursement Program designed to increase teacher retention. Action was deferred. <p>L. Trinidad called into the meeting. Presented the Teacher Development Program. K. Pineda-Akiona questioned the calculations which L. Trinidad said were estimates. The program is not a reimbursement but similar to a scholarship.
